Re: Non-Compliance with the Environmental Permit for Construction of new highway

An officer of the National Environment and Planning Agency (NEPA) conducted a Post Permit Inspection of the Highway of Moneague to Mammee Bay, St. Ann on 24 April 2015. The following breach of Specific Condition of the permit was highlighted during the visit:

SC34. The Permittee and/or its agents shall develop and implement a comprehensive plan to control the generation of fugitive dust to include periodic wetting of friable materials and the phased clearing of areas to ensure there is no fugitive dust emission to create a nuisance during the construction phase.

You are hereby instructed to control the generation of fugitive dust within 5 days of the effective date of this letter. This letter represents an official warning and failure to comply will result in escalated enforcement action without reference to you.

The effective date of this letter is 4 May 2015.
